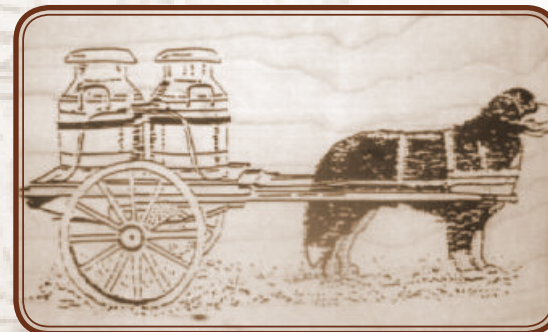
Directions to the Draft Test Site

Additional 2011 Draft Test Information

The Draft Test Committee will exercise due care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs entered but will not be responsible for nor assume any liability in the event of any accident or other misfortune to any dog, entrant or patron.

Complete information regarding this test will be sent out with the entry acknowledgements. For specific information please contact the Test Secretary.

Refreshments: There will be light (warm) lunch items available for purchase..

Weather: August can be hot and dry. There will be two coverings for shade for seating but xpens and shelters are recommended for your dogs. Please be sure to bring/wear cool clothing. Sturdy shoes are also recommended for field work.

Regulations: It is the responsibility of the entrant to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Draft Dog Test Rules and Regulations are available online or from the Canadian Kennel Club Order Desk. Tel: 1-800-250-8040

CKC Regulation 17.6: Any person, either within or outside the judging area, who does anything calculated to attract, distract or otherwise interfere in any way with the attention, deportment, or performance of a dog under judgement, may be disciplined by the Discipline Committee in whatever way it considers to be in the best interest of the club, or the judge may take summary action.

CKC Regulation 17.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, steward, volunteer or competitor at a Draft Dog test is not subject to indignities. The Draft Dog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Group Option The Group Option as stated in Section 11.2 is not offered at this test

Equipment: Each entrant is to supply their own equipment. DDX and BDDX entrants will require their own backpacks and backpack load. The freight load for all entrants will be supplied by the test committee.

General Information and Test Rules

Eligibility: This test is open to all purebred CKC recognized & CKC miscellaneous breed dogs eighteen months of age or older on the day of the event. Entries in the Brace Draft Dog test must have a CKC Draft Dog (DD) Title. The Judges must excuse a dog at any time during a test for lack of physical capacity. Entries in the Draft Dog Excellent Test must have a CKC Draft Dog (DD) Title. Entries in the Brace Draft Dog Excellent Test must have previously earned a CKC Draft Dog Excellent Title and a CKC Brace Draft Dog (BDD) Title

Entry Fee: \$80.00 (Cdn or US funds) per team & \$9.30 listing fee per listed dog (payable to the Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Ontario). Mail entries to the Draft Test Secretary.

Entry Limits: There will be entry limits of 10 DD or BDD and 5 DDX or BDDX teams. If either limit has been reached by the closing date and the other limit is not filled, substitute test openings will be filled as directed in section 6.9.2 of the CKC Draft Dog Test Rules and Regulations. Entries are accepted on a first come, first served basis with preference being given to Bernese Mountain Dogs. Entry space not filled by Bernese will then be available to other breeds. Requalifications are accepted pending 'space available'. Re-qualifications shall be judged as the last team in the section for which they are entered.

Closing Date: 5:00pm, Friday August 12, 2011 or when the limits of 10 DD or BDD and 5 DDX or BDDX teams has been reached even if the official closing date for entries has not arrived. If either limit is reached prior to the closing date, a list of alternates will be kept to fill any vacancies created due to early (prior to closing date) cancellations or to create substitute test openings. Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date with the exception of alternates that do not get to compete. To comply with instructions issued by the CKC, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching the Test Secretary after the closing date as published in the premium list or after the maximum number of entries has been received.

Entries: Entries must be complete, signed and submitted on the official CKC entry form. One entry for DD, DDX, BDD, BDDX per envelope. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fee. Telephone and fax entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Cancellations of any entry after the closing day is prohibited. The order of competing shall be the order that entries are received except that dogs handled by the same person will be separated when possible. No delays will be permitted for handlers entering more than one dog and entrants doing so must have an alternate handler available for the group down exercise if a conflict arises..

Bitches in Season: Bitches in season will be allowed to compete but all exercises will be judged after all other dogs have been tested. Bitches in season must be kept away from the test site prior to testing

Foreign Born / Owned Dogs: If a dog is not registered individually with the CKC, it may be entered at a test held under these regulations, as a 'Listed' dog, provided that it has an event registration number (ERN), or obtains this from the CKC within 30 days of the first test entered otherwise scores will be cancelled. In order to enter Canada a dog must have a Rabies certificate dated at least 30 days prior to reentry into the U.S.

Confirmation of Entry: After the closing date all entrants will be notified by email, telephone or mail of their placement.

Awards and Prizes: All participating entrants will receive a 2011 Draft Test ring favour. Rosettes will be presented for each qualifying score earned.
